

# Revancha, La Gran 2011 Mendoza

*King (chess piece) label. 60% Malbec, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot, 5% Cabernet Franc. Vineyards in Drummond, Perdriel, Altamira, at altitudes of 980-1,100 m. Fermented in 80 hl tanks with manual pigeage, malo in barrel. Aged 18 months in French oak, 50% new. Minimum filtration.*

Very dark with black core and elderberry rim. More firmly dark-fruited than the two varietal Malbecs (Peon and La Primera), some cassis from the Cabernet Sauvignon, and with a lovely savoury darkness, gently brooding at the moment. Rich and creamy textured with a deep texture and excellent cool length and as with the Malbec, a clean, dry finish. (JH)
